Lloyd W. Arner, 95, Carthage died at 1:39 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2000, from smoke inhalation at a fire at his home.

Mr. Arner was born Aug. 9, 1905, in Lamar to George and Maryetta Wright Arner. He was a farmer and played in the Mo-Kan Baseball League. He published two books of poetry, "Youth Sings" and "Purple Hills" and a novel, "Sandy." He was a member of First Baptist Church, Carthage.
