

MARIE LOUISE BANWART

Marie Louise Banwart, 89, of Sabetha, Ks., a former Lamar, Mo. resident, passed away at 1:35 a.m., Friday, Feb. 2, 2001 at the Apostolic Christian Nursing Home in Sabetha.

Marie was born March 12, 1911, to Ben and Celia (Marti) Banwart, of rural Lamar, Mo.

In 1914, the family moved to Morris, Minn., where they farmed and she received her grade school education. The family returned to Lamar in 1928. Marie worked as a housekeeper until 1954 when she became a Licensed Practical Nurse. She then worked at Barton County Memorial Hospital for many years.

In May, 1988, Marie and her sister, Pearl, moved to Sabetha, Ks., into an apartment at the Apostolic Christian Retirement Village, where she resided several years before entering the nursing home.

Marie was converted and baptized in November, 1934. She was a member of the Apostolic Christian Church and remained faithful until death.

She is survived by three brothers and their wives, Arthur and Ruth Banwart, Lamar, Mo.; Raymond and Kathryn Banwart, Ft. Scott, Ks.; and Lloyd "Spud" and Sue Banwart, Springfield, Mo.
