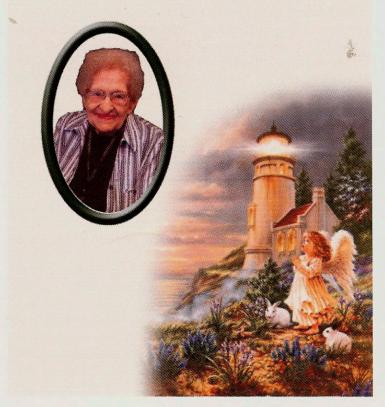
Velma Amalia Bohne, age 98, of Springfield, formerly of Lamar, passed away Wednesday, March 26, 2014 at Cox South Hospital.
